DESCRIPTION

Out Eastern Course combines11 days in Valencia (homestay) which classes and activities plus 5 days in an adventure camp. Students take a placement test on the first day so that the groups all have the same level. Morning classes are held from 9am to 1pm in our school. Our Classes are taught entirely in Spanish and cover all 4 skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing). They are well structured and balanced and students work throughout personalized projects which provide them with the necessary tools to get the best out of their afternoon and free times activities. This practica approach means that our students make full use of what they have learnt from the very first day.

Afternoons are spent doing organized activities (accompanied by a teacher at all times).

Accommodation

Host Families

To ensure that our students enjoy their stay with us and take full advantage of their time in Spain, we consider homestay accommodation to be a fundamental part of the experience. It is ideal for total immersion in the Spanish language, lifestyle, culture and cuisine. Living with a host family means experiencing a new city like a local, rather than a visitor and is by far the best way to learn about life in the host country, helping students to lose their inhibitions and make an effort to communicate with their host family.

To guarantee the most immersive experience possible, there will only be ONE student in each host family. Our host families are all carefully selected by us and live in the same neighbourhood as our school. As we personally organize and manage the homestay accommodation and the classes, we are in constant contact with the students to answer any doubts they may have.

Bedroom:	All students will be provided with their own bedroom with a wardrobe and desk where they can do their coursework.
Full board:	(breakfast, lunch + dinner). Students will be provided with a packed lunch from Monday to Friday and the rest of the meals will be with the host family.

Adventure Camp

from 14/04/2017 to 18/04/2017

Students will sleep in shared bedrooms with bathrooms, with bed linen and towels provided with full board.
